CCP-USSR CONCLUDE TWO SECRET PACTS

Tokyo, 16 October (CNA) -- Two secret agreements, the Ha-erh-pin (Harbin) Agreement and the Moscow Pact, were recently concluded by the Chinese Communist bandits with the USSR, granting the latter almost exclusive territorial sovereignty over China. The contexts of the agreements are as follows:

Ha-erh-pin Agreement

1. In both foreign and military affairs, the USSR will give complete support to the CCP.
2. The USSR and CCP will cooperate in developing Northeast economy.
3. The CCP will recognize the special land and air communication rights of the USSR in the Northeast.
4. The USSR will, at all times, supply and help maintain the Chinese Red Army Air Force of 50 aircraft.
5. All captured Japanese arms still in possession of the USSR will be turned over to the CCP in two installments.
6. The USSR will sell to the CCP, at a reasonable cost, munitions and military supplies of every description under Russian control in the Northeast.
7. Should it ever encounter military reverses in the Northeast, the Chinese Red Army will be permitted to withdraw into Russian territory through North Korea.
8. In the event that Nationalist forces effect a landing in the Northeast to launch an offensive the USSR will secretly assist the Chinese Red Army.
9. The USSR will permit the Chinese Red Army to establish air force training centers at Ch'ing-t'a [possibly Tynda or Tynda] and in North Korea.

10. The CCP will supply all intelligence information on KMT China and the United States.

11. With the exception of that required for domestic consumption, the entire production of cotton, soya beans, and essential war materials in the North-east will be exported to Russia.

12. The USSR will assist the CCP in expanding its influence in Sinkiang.

13. Specified areas in Liaoning and Antung will be available for the stationing of North Korean troops and will be annexed to Korea at some appropriate future time.

Moscow Fact

1. The USSR will be given priority in mining rights in Chinese territory. A joint Sino-Soviet enterprise known as the China Commercial Company (Chung-hua Sheng-yeh Kung-ssu) will be established to implement these rights.

2. The USSR will be given the right to station troops in the Northeast and Sinkiang.

3. In the event of another world war, the Chinese Red Army will fight on the side of the USSR. The over-all supreme commander will be appointed by the USSR and the deputy supreme commander by the Chinese Red Army.

4. The USSR will assist in building China's air force.

5. A Far Eastern Cominform will be established in China.

6. In the event hostilities break out in Europe involving the USSR, the CCP will dispatch an expeditionary force of 100,000 troops and one million laborers to assist the USSR war effort.

7. In the near future the USSR will train and equip 11 Chinese Red Army divisions.
